DOORCO UK is in a unique position thanks to our state-of-the-art automated production facility in South Korea, with which we work in close partnership. The DOORCO door offers a high level of security, with increased resistance to forced entry, and reinforced GRP skins as standard. It has passed the rigours of PAS 24 in line with Approved Document Q. With DOORCO, the emphasis is firmly on choice with regards supply to our customers.

Volume users looking for the most cost effective solution or an alternative specification to meet individual requirements can order containers from our Korea facility. Whilst our UK distribution centre provides next day delivery on door blanks from stock and a 4 day service on prepped doors with full options, including cassette and glass supply from market leaders Regalead and ODL, as well as bespoke paint options from our in-house paint line.









Composite Construction and GRP Skins

Manufactured using grained reinforced GRP skins, our industry leading composite door slab is the closest in appearance to wood, but without the associated maintenance requirements. Maintaining the kerb appeal of traditional timber, the construction of our door surpasses other alternatives, incorporating an LVL (Laminated Veneer Lumber) subframe to provide the strength and rigidity required for modern homes. The door protects you home from the elements, but will have minimal thermal expansion and contraction rates under extreme temperature variations which is perfectly normal. The PU foam core meanwhile reduces heat loss, providing a high level of thermal performance.



Reglazeable Cassette System

The industry leading TriSys glazing system from ODL Europe, is a company with a 10+ year heritage in innovation, quality and added value. The game changing, 3 part TriSys glazing system allows easy installation of the glass option, and easy replacement if your choice of glass design were to change, or a breakage were to occur, without changing the front door.

Integrated Venetian Blind

Cleverly encapsulated within the insulated glass cavity, the Venetian blind provides a zero-maintenance solution to our Lytham door style. The blind can be easily raised, lowered and tilted using the unobtrusive fingertip control on the edge of the frame.



Suited Furniture

A range of suited door handles, letterplates, door knockers and numerals are usually available, in chrome, gold, white, black and, style dependent, a selection in stainless steel which will be advised at point of order.



We recommend all doors should have the most up-to-date security hardware fitted, including multipoint locks and high security cylinders - currently specified as grade TS007.



Low Threshold

The majority of doors will be fitted with a thermally broken, low threshold option, which should be Part M compliant. There may also be the option of full frame and PVC cill combinations.

Thermal Performance

Composite doors are much more thermally efficient than either timber or PVC, and our doors are manufactured to the highest quality standards, making them more thermally efficient by design.

The warm foam core allows the door to have a significantly better 'U' value than traditional timber doors, PVC skinned timber doors and steel doors, and our entire range meets with the requirements of the current Building Regulations.

There are various upgrades to glass options which increase the thermal performance of the door.

The combination should keep your home warmer and could help reduce your energy bills.





Performance

Our door offers a truly appealing finish for the entrance of any home, with a high definition embossed and grained GRP outer skin which will look stunning for years to come. The door offers stability from the elements with its inner core of LVL encased with composite stiles and rails for protection against any water ingress. Our doors usually have a grained PVC edge to the hinge and lock side in either white, stain or paint finish.

The inner core is manufactured from high density polyurethane foam, which offers exceptional thermal efficiency and will help to reduce

Security - Keeping You Safe

We take security very seriously so we invested some years ago in a new breed of composite door with significantly improved security features which stand up to current and future security standards, including PAS 24 in line with Approved Document Q for new build.



We recommend the use of multipoint locks as standard (which should be engaged at all times and not left on the latch) as well security hardware including TS007 standards, and high security cylinders with anti-pick, anti-bump and anti-snap capabilities. On certain style we would also

recommend a high level, multipoint, slam shut lock with key entry plus security escutcheon, providing a traditional rim latch lock.

Glass units which comply with Approved Document Q must contain one pane of class P1A (EN356) glass, which must be

6.8mm, security laminated. This is available as an option on glass within our doors at a reasonable additional cost.

Colours

With our high performance paint technology and in-house paint line, we can offer a wide range of shades for all of our doors which can even complement the colour options on frames, and so providing a fantastic choice for the home. In most cases the doors come in white as standard on the internal side, however, for your own individual requirements we may be able to offer different or bespoke options, so please speak to your retailer for more information.

Glass and Glazing -Making a Personal Statement

The visual impact of your door is enhanced by the choice of glass within. Depending on the style, you will have either a double or triple glazed unit, but all units are supplied as Energy Plus, incorporating 'Low E' glass and Argon gas filled. The glazing cassette system is re-glazeable and has passed the PAS 24 security attack tests. For back door applications you can even benefit from an integrated Venetian Blind, incorporating child-friendly, unobtrusive finger control and no loose cords.

Traditional Doors

The range of traditional doors are designed to replicate the most popular timber doors and come with highly defined mouldings and realistic wood-grain embossing on the surface. Whether used in a Victorian home, a modern townhouse or a farmhouse cottage, these doors always add to the appearance of the entrance.

These doors are transformed by the choice of decorative glass and colours, with 39 door colours available and a huge range of glass options, from the simple diamonds of Classic, through to the stunning multi-faced bevelling and black chrome caming of Reflections, these doors can make a real statement.
